


PASTOR DEBRA'S FALL BIBLE STUDIES

This ten-week Bible study will guide us through the Old Testament and introduce the Books of the Apocrypha. We will explore basic themes, histories, personalities, and meanings of the scriptures.

The Books of the Apocrypha, positioned between the Old and New Testaments, were part of the Bible until the Protestant Reformation. These books, often called the Deuterocanonical Books, continue to be used as scripture by the Catholic Church.


Well-known educator Don Griggs has written an accessible, easy-to-understand overview of the Old Testament for adults who have--or fear they have--little or no Bible knowledge.




ADVENT AND CHRISTMAS
